INDIRECT COST RATE:

The negotiated indirect cost rate approved for the LEA applies to this grant award, if applicable in the LEA grant application.

PERIOD OF AVAILABILITY:

Under the General Education Provision Act and in compliance with the Tydings Amendment, federal funds are available for grantee use for 27 months. The following grants are subject to a carryover limit after the first 15 months of grant availability:

Title I, Part A – 15%

Title V, REAP – 5%

The ADE disburses federal funds on a reimbursement basis.

Homeless is on a 3-year cycle (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22) the grant will end on Sept 30, 2022.

21st Century is on a 5-year cycle, each program has a different end date. Keep this in mind when considering obligation dates.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The above LEA is hereby awarded a grant of funds under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), for the purpose of ensuring that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments. Grant funds are also awarded under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

Funds must be accounted for separately based on the funding source and year. Funds must be expended in accordance with the Arkansas Public School Computer Network (APSCN) School Financial Accounting Manual and federal and state statutes.

The Notice of Grant Award included is based upon the information contained in each school's application relating to the plans which have been reviewed; however, neither receiving the Notice of Grant Award for this plan by the State Education Agency (SEA), nor the issuance of this award notice, shall in any way relieve the LEA of its responsibility to comply with the applicable requirements such as the Title I Non-Regulatory Guidance, Education Department General Administrative Regulation (EDGAR) Plus Office of Management and Budget (OMB), Uniform Grants Guidance, Cost Allocation Guidance and Time-and-Effort Guidance. Remember, in general, the supplement not supplant requirement is intended to ensure that services are in addition to, and do not replace or supplant, services that students would otherwise receive.

The LEA is responsible for managing all expenditures and balances. All funds must be included in APSCN budgets. Any amendments to the grant application must be submitted to the ADE, Federal Programs Unit and must receive formal, written approval before being implemented.

The following actions may occur if noncompliance issues (2CFR 200.338) cannot be remedied by the schools with specific conditions:

Temporarily withhold cash payment pending correction
Disallow all or part of the cost

Wholly or partly suspend or terminate the Federal award (see 2 CFR 200.339 Termination)
Withhold further Federal awards for the project or program

All school districts have an Educational Excellence Trust Fund EETF Alloc that is included within the district's foundation funding. The EETF allocation represents the portion of foundation funding that must be spent on non-federal licensed salaries and fringe, pursuant to ACA 6-5-307 and Rules Governing the School District Educational Excellence Trust . EETF

No school district shall receive both declining enrollment funding and student growth funding in the same year. No school district shall receive both declining enrollment funding and special needs isolated funding in the same year. Eligible school districts receive the higher of student growth funding plus special needs (isolated/small district/transportation) funding or declining enrollment funding.
